

This is not a "learn how to plumb your entire new construction house book". I gave it a good review because despite it not being what I needed it was thorough on what it did explain and would be good for fixing existing plumbing projects.

I recently hauled this book out of my bookcase to replace some faucets in the bathroom sink. Granted, the Moen kit was exemplary in its instructions and simplicity, but you still might find yourself without the necessary tools or tips to get the job done, much less done in time for dinner. The book really saved me some time and effort. On its advice, I picked up a basin wrench, and this alone saved the job. I would never have gotten the old hardware off, much less gotten the new hardware on, without it. It also outlined the need for flexible feed hoses, wrapping the new faucet feeds before installing (which I forgot to do, but the book did its part and told me about it), and outlining the basics step by step.Coupled with a most excellent purely-pictorial instruction manual in the Moen kit, I was able to remove the old leaky faucets, install the new ones, and not have to hire a plumber. The book could be even bigger and include a little more depth, but this is a highly-recommended resource and every non-contractor or non-handy individual should own Home Depots construction books are always good. Easily undersood and reasonably priced. We are building a tiny home right now and use them all the time.
