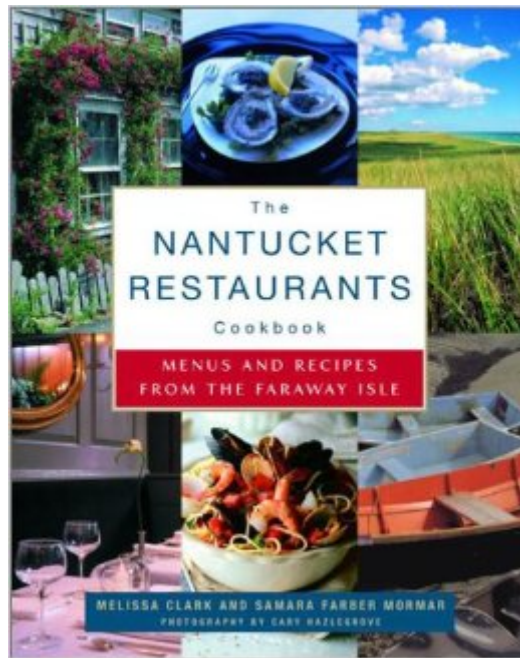

I was hoping there would be an errata shown, but haven't seen it.
