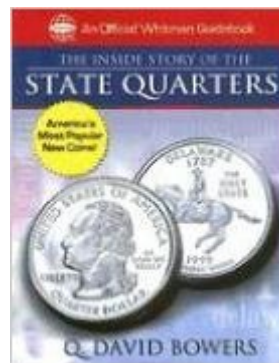

I normally love Q. David Bowers books. But this book was created too early. The book really only covers through 2005. The remaining quarters apparently hadn't been produced yet so minimal coverage was made on them. I was disappointed to say the least.

This is just the book we were looking for! While the US Mint's collection looks to be nicer, the \$7/state price tag is a bit much for our kids (3 1/2 & 6). So we looked around and found this gem of a book. This book, paired with the Whitman State Quarters Map (<http://www..com/gp/product/0794821944>) are a great combination. This book contains:- About the State Quarters Program - Two-page Overview of the Mint's program- Quarters, State by State - Two-page descriptions of each state's quarters, through the 2005 releases - States for 2006, 2007, & 2008 get summarized descriptions of what the quarters were planned to look like over two pages- States of the Union - All 50 states, in order of admission to the Union, then get a single page apiece, each including: - Front and back of each quarter (no backs for 2006-2008) - State's location on a US map - Outline of the state, with the Capital city identified - Fun facts, including Capital, State Tree, Land Size, Rank in Size, State Song, and Largest City - Image of the State Flag

This is a little more technical than I wanted. I was looking for something for my 7 and 9 year old. But a very nice book for older collectors.
