

The (Third) edition of Michael Bazzellâ ™s â œHiding from the Internetâ • should warm the hearts of the usual suspects: sleuths, spooks, and anyone else who wants to either plumb or avoid the depths of the personal privacy data hemorrhage on the Internet. It's rare to find anyone who is not affected in some way -- at least not in the United States. This book has been updated and rearranged and offers new chapters on: obtaining completely anonymous smartphone numbers; publishing web pages for your small business without registering your home address; creating aliases including names and legal identification; how to respond if or when your personal data leaks onto the Internet, and how to purchase "invisible" homes and motor vehicles. Bazzell explains in explicit detail how your personal information gets on the Internet. For openers, think telephone numbers, home addresses, birthdates, family member names, email addresses, vehicle ownership, voter records, and social network activity. Then he shows how you can remove much of this information. Some data falls in the category of "public records," not meant to be removed, e.g. real property ownership, court records and voter registration. Still, there are steps you can try to make even this information less visible. Example: when buying a new home you can absolutely avoid having your name attached. The book will show you which web search engines you can use to ferret out your personal data, how to do the searches, and where to find websites (examples: Spokeo and Zabasearch) that offer up your personal information for a few bucks (or free) to anyone who wants it.
