

I'm being generous with 4 stars. I'm an expert stitcher so almost all of these patterns are not interesting to me, not enough of a challenge. But I don't want to diss this book just because it's too easy for me. On the other hand, this book is geared toward raw beginners and as such it is really sparse on directions. First: don't I have to worry about my fabric edges unraveling? How do I prevent my floss twisting? If 14-count aida is the most commonly used embroidery fabric, why is every project stitched on 28-count evenweave? Some projects require fractional stitches which can only be made when stitching over 2 threads...but what are these doing in a book that is supposed to be easy and calming? Second, some of these projects require a LOT of counting which is very tedious and not in a soothing way. Just because a project calls for only 1 color of floss does not make it easy. For example, the Bonsai tree has a stitch count of 214 by 116. If you don't know, 214

stitches is over 15" long on the fabric. It would be one thing if these stitches were in straight lines but the branches are very twisty and asymmetrical. The counting for a new stitcher might be very frustrating. Also, the stitch diagrams leave something to be desired: for some reason I can't figure out, you can make horizontal rows of cross stitches by making one leg of each stitch going right or left and then finishing each cross on the way back. These are much more even than if you made each stitch separately. But you cannot use this method vertically. For some reason, the stitches are elongated and don't provide the correct coverage. The author, however, says you can cross-stitch in any direction.
